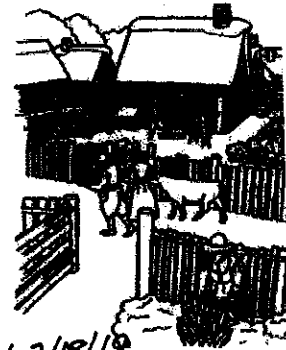

DAY TWO TUESDAY MAY 7, 2019

This morning we will visit and tour **Thomas Jefferson's Monticello**. We will experience a guided tour of the home and gardens here. As you tour the home, the genius of the man presents itself through his works and designs. This tour offers an in-depth look at one of America's greatest leaders and patriots.

This afternoon, we will stop and tour **Colonial Williamsburg**. This tour of Williamsburg, Virginia's colonial capital, features restored colonial buildings and historical sights. Costumed interpreters add to the enjoyment of this tour as they go about the day to day activities of life in Virginia during the 1700's.

OVERNIGHT: WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA

DAY THREE WEDNESDAY MAY 8, 2019

BREAKFAST IS INCLUDED AT OUR HOTEL THIS MORNING

We begin today with a visit to and tour of **Jamestown Settlement**. It was in this area that the first English settlers arrived and established Jamestown in 1607. There are world class exhibits and displays inside the visitor's center and, outside the center one can walk through the colonist's fort and the adjacent Powhatan Indian Village and, even board the replicas of the three ships which brought the settlers across the Atlantic Ocean from England so many years ago. As you wander the grounds, there are costumed interpreters to answer questions and enhance your visit.

This afternoon, we will take the short drive to visit and tour the **American Revolution Museum at Yorktown**. At this sight on October 19, 1781, Colonial forces under the command of George Washington combined with French forces to defeat the mighty English army and bring about an end to our War for Independence and a beginning for the United States of America.

The experiential theater here, is complete with wind, smoke and the thunder of cannon fire to put you in the middle of the action of the siege of Yorktown.

Along with the exhibits and films inside the museum, the outdoor settings feature a Continental Army encampment with costumed interpreters to help us experience a day in the camp of the Continental Army.

After a day spent enjoying Jamestown and Yorktown, we will take the short drive to return to Williamsburg for the evening..

DAY FOUR THURSDAY MAY 9, 2019

Today, we will turn for home. This morning, we will visit and tour the **Virginia State Capitol Building in Richmond**.

Following our tour of the capitol and a break for lunch, we will proceed west and south through Virginia's Springtime Splendor to reach our overnight accommodations.

Due to limited availability, we require a deposit of \$100.00 per person which is due to assure space.

Space will be reserved according to our receipt of deposits. 4 to 6 weeks prior to departure, you will receive a final itinerary and information. At that time, we request you send the balance payment for tour.

Should it be necessary for you to cancel, please let us know as soon as possible. Your deposit is refundable up to (30) days prior to departure. Within (30) days of departure, your payment will be refunded if we are able to fill your space. Otherwise, we cannot refund to you costs which we have incurred on your behalf.

Because we work primarily with senior citizens, we are aware of the special nature of the problems which can occur, and we do not intend to penalize you should you have to cancel due to illness. We do need to ask your consideration and understanding in this matter since any cancellation not filled costs us money.

In the case of tours costing over \$500.00, you may wish to purchase travel insurance. If so, we will send you the information from the travel insurance company we have used for quite a few years with excellent service.

When you purchase this insurance plan, please keep in mind that your insurance purchase must be made within (21) days of your initial tour deposit.
